MGNFP is a two-year blended program, with both academic and district field immersion modules aimed at creating a cadre of individuals to strengthen functioning of national and state institutions in design and management of effective skilling, training, and employment ecosystem in the country.

The program focuses on translation of skills to entrepreneurship, decent work and well-being, and sustainable development.
