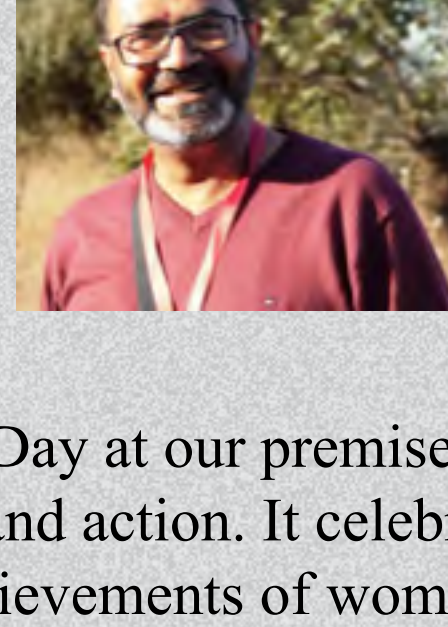


Note from our founder

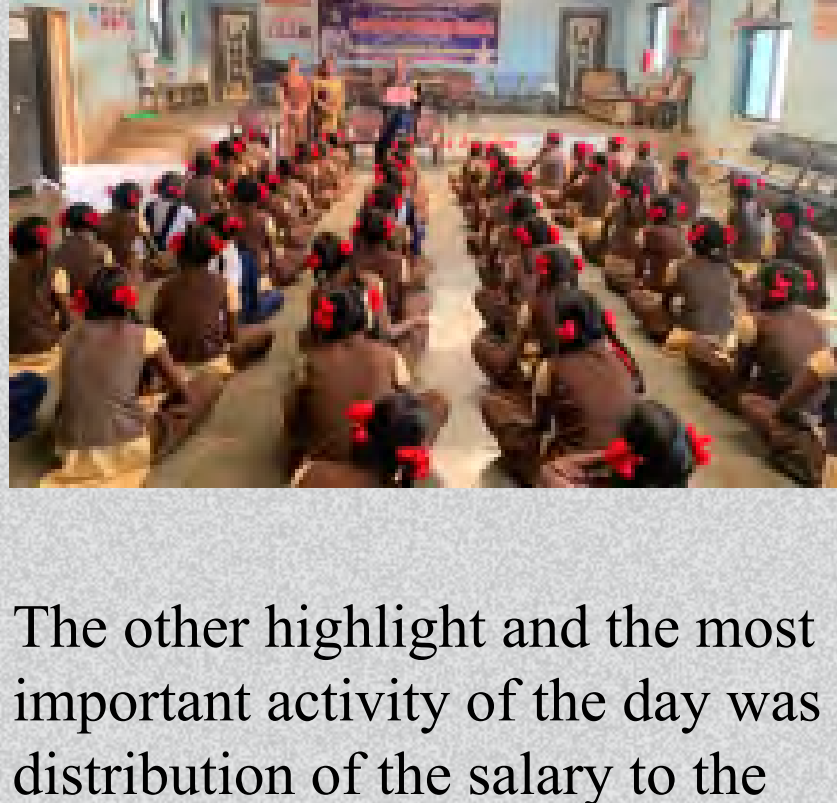
Women's Day Celebration at Walwanda village



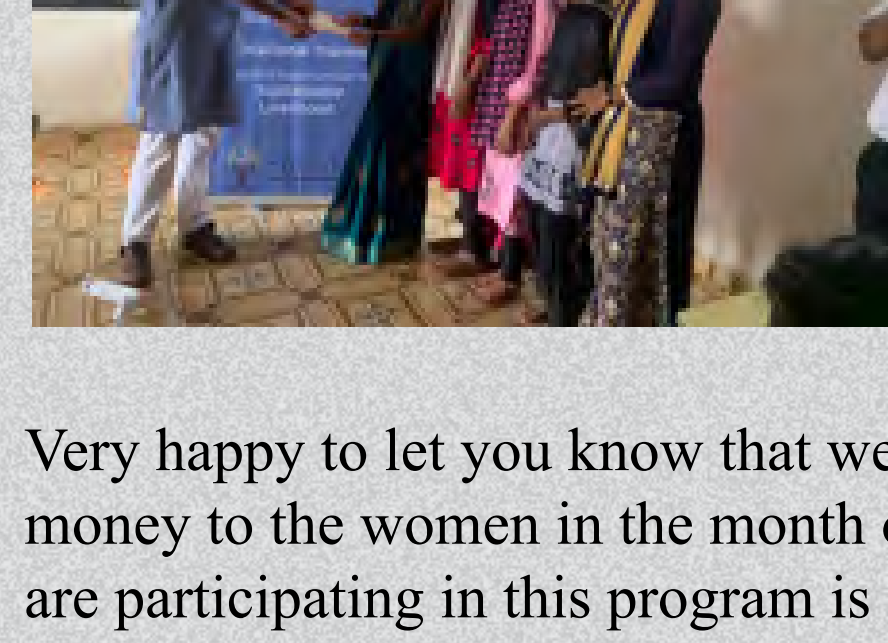
The day started with the distribution of certificates to the 3rd batch of women who have completed their training on basics of tailoring at our Community Tailoring Center.

We believe that the very knowledge of menstrual cycle as a normal biological process in a woman's body would make them fearless and unapologetic while discussing the subject with anyone else.

A session on Menstrual hygiene and safe disposal was conducted by M/s. Nisarg Foundation from Thane. Dr. Lata Ghanshamani and her team spoke to our students and the children of the Adivasi High School... the session was followed by distribution of menstrual cups to the women.



The other highlight and the most important activity of the day was distribution of the salary to the women who worked to produce various products for which we received bulk orders during the previous month...

Both the women & the farmers have been trained by us in the vocation of their choice, i.e., basics of tailoring and poultry farming.

Distribution of Sanitary pads among women

Apart from generating awareness of the menstrual hygiene among the local community, we also distributed sanitary pads among them in the month of March...

Donated by benevolent donors, the pads were made by our students and distributed among women in the Ramkhind village in the Jawhar taluka, thereby achieving two milestones with one activity, i.e. livelihood of the students (who made the sanitary pads) and health and menstrual hygiene for the community.
